I have 3 counting the one of the whole platoon Bob was killed at the Anzio beach a year ago this month. He was reported missing April 21 and on July 24 we got the telegram that instead he had been killed in action. Everywhere I look at the pictures I wonder if Frank was lucky enough to escape so far. He was going to patrol when they left Camp Croft, and Bob was sent to an embarkation post - thick of them in fact, but finally went overseas in August. Bob felt very badly when he and Frank were separated. He thought

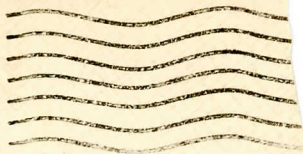
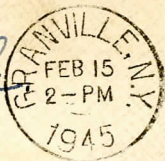
