Chaplain will bless it for you.

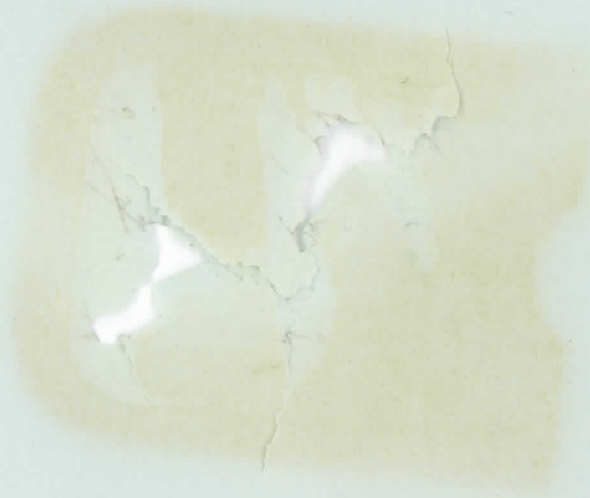
Frank told me
