



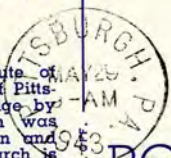
THE NEW BUILDING OF MELLON INSTITUTE

The essential aim of Mellon Institute of Industrial Research at the University of Pittsburgh is the creation of new knowledge by scientific investigation. The institution was founded by Messrs. Andrew W. Mellon and Richard B. Mellon. Its industrial research is being conducted by some sixty Fellowships each relating to a different subject. It also maintains a Department of Research in Pure Chemistry, in which fundamental studies are carried on for the benefit of the chemical profession and of humanity. The research staff is constituted of 150 specialists.

In its work for the industries the Institute is primarily a technologic experiment station. Researches completed by Industrial Fellowships have given rise to ten new industries and to many new branches of manufacture.
