

Lt. John F. Duffy Killed in Air Crash

Overseas since last December and with 31 completed missions over Germany, 2d

Lt. John F.

Duffy, a navigator in the 8th Air Force, was killed in a plane crash in England on May 5, his parents, Edward and Jen-



nie Woods Duffy and Lt. John F. Duffy of 364 72d St., have been informed by the War Department. He was their only child.

Born in Brooklyn 22 years ago, Lieutenant Duffy was graduated from the parish school of Our Lady of Angels and St. Michael's High School and had been employed by the American Gas & Electric Company, Manhattan. He was a student at St. John's University when he enlisted in November, 1942. He received his commission Sept. 4, 1944, at Selman Field, Monroe, La.

A solemn mass of requiem will be offered for him at 9:30 a.m. Monday in Our Lady of Angels R. C. Church, 4th Ave. and 73d St.
